# Regional Toxicology Liaison - Quarterly Reflection and Progress Report

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Quarter reported: April – June 2022

The Regional Toxicology Liaisons (RTLs) have been very busy keeping up with the meetings and conferences within their Regions. The response from partners such as the Law Enforcement Liaisons (LEL), Judicial Outreach Liaisons (JOLs), Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutors (TSRPs), and Drug Recognition Experts (DRE) has been very favorable. A list of laboratories and contacts in each Region has been established and the RTLs have met with most, if not all, of the laboratories in their Regions.

The RTLs have had requests to join various working groups and task forces. With each invitation, the RTL requests to include a representative from the state laboratory. The feedback from the laboratories has been very positive as they are often overlooked for participation. Joining together the laboratories and respective partners is still occurring and will continue as the project progresses.

Feedback from the laboratories have all indicated a strong need for courtroom and testimony training. The RTLs will be preparing a curriculum that can be modified by each laboratory to meet their needs. Funding sources will be sought to support the creation and dissemination of the curriculum which will include train the trainer sessions. The RTLs will begin this project at the end of 2022/early 2023.

In June, each RTL held the first of what will eventually be quarterly meetings for each region. The initial meetings were a "meet and greet" style with opening remarks by the NHTSA RAS. The RTLs requested each laboratory respond to a brief survey prior to the meetings to understand current needs, any supply shortages, and topics for further discussion. Future meetings will have a specific topic focus followed by a discussion.
